## **Personal requirement:**

The corresponding author has a verifiable legal relationship with Semmelweis University and indicates his/her Semmelweis affiliation on the publication.

## **Selected journal requirement:**

The journal is on the „list of supported journals.”

## **Publication requirement:**

The type of publication is „scientific publication”

# Open Access support process

## **Before submitting your manuscript:**

Collecting information, choosing a journal.

## **Uploading the manuscript to the publisher's editorial system**

## **Publisher's peer review**

The publisher will confirm acceptance/rejection of the article to the author and the Central Library.

## **Publication support**

The Central Library will request the publication from the author for verification.

## **Feedback**

Central Library provides feedback to publisher and APC will be deducted from our quota (no invoice will be generated).

# Submitting a new publication

The author submits his/her manuscript to the „editorial manager” system. The links provide a clear description of the upload process and the contact details of the person responsible.



# Peer review

The editors invite independent, open-minded reviewers with experience in the field to comment on the relevance of the research question, the weight of the findings and whether the manuscript is well written.

Based on their recommendation, the Editor-in-Chief decides whether to accept the article for publication.

Once the article has been peer-reviewed, the author is required to sign a licensing agreement.

# Signature of the licence agreement

Additionally, in order to publish an accepted article, the author must sign a licence agreement giving the rights to the publisher to publish the article for the first time. The form at the link below must be completed, signed and sent to the Academic Publisher.
