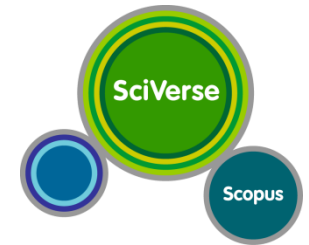

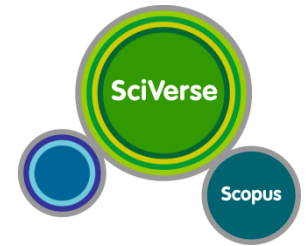

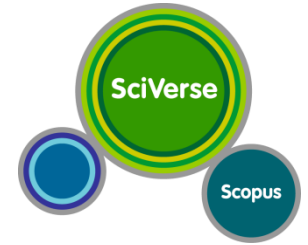

Task 1



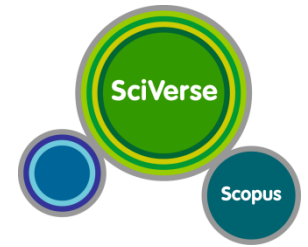

Task 2



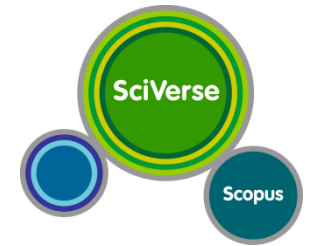
