Our feedback on the results of the students' survey:

The questionnaire for Library Informatics (subject code: AOVKPK088_1A) was completed by approx. 41% of the students. The action plan for the academic year 2020/2021 has been successful, as the results were almost all above the faculty average.

To capture the interest of students, both at the beginning of the programme and at the beginning of each module, we will emphasize more clearly why the course, the given databases and topics are useful and important.

The online lectures' attendance is not compulsory, the recorded lectures are available for a few months after the classes, so the score of the question related to the attendance is not relevant in this case. There is no official textbook for Library Informatics subject, therefore the question about that is not relevant either.

Our feedback on the general comments of the students:

We will continue to strive to maintain the quality of the course, by keeping the teaching material up-todate and by introducing new resources (e.g. Embase database) depending on subscriptions.
