Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("implementation review"):

In general, students are satisfied with the content and structure of the course. There is now almost 1 week instead of 24 hours to complete the module tests and automatic saving has been introduced. All this has been well received by the students.

Our feedback on the results of the students' survey:

The questionnaire for Library Informatics (subject code: AOVKPK1027_1A) was completed by 47% of the students.

Among the top scores, we highlight the well-organized teaching of the course (K02) and the high rating of the Moodle interface of the course (K05). Various additional materials on the Moodle platform of the subject support the preparation of students' learning. The students assessed the lectures and presentations to be more useful, dynamic and logical than the faculty average (K03).

The evaluation of teaching of the subject (K06) was generally in line with the faculty average – as for the two remaining questions.
