Samuel Karger (21.5.1863 – 1.7.1935)




- Founded S. Karger Publishers 1890 in Berlin (Germany)
- 1915: in the middle of WW I:
 25th anniversary of Karger (the portfolio comprises 8 journals and 50 book titles)
- 1935: approx. 850 publications (language: German)

"Vademecum" – The First Karger Publication


- Portable reference work on obstetrics
- Translated into English, French, Italian, Polish, Polish, Russian,
 Greek and Turkish
- 15 editions over the years

This very first publication was an instant hit: it sold out in less than six months!





Heinz Karger (10.11.1895 – 27.3.1959)




- 1935: Takes over S. Karger Publishers
- 1937: Move from Berlin to Basel
 The Karger Portfolio encompasses 7 journals at the time
- 1940: In the middle of WW II: Karger Publishers has its 50-year anniversary

New Subject Fields

- 1952: 7 years after the war,
 Karger publishes 27 journals regularly
- Languages: German, French and English

Thomas Karger (born 17.2.1930)




- 1959: Takes over S. Karger Publishers at the age of 29 years
- 1960: Founding of Karger Libri Subscription Agency
- 1965: 75th anniversary 38 journals
- 1990: 100th anniversary 78 journals

Transition from German to English

 1960: Switch of publication program to English

Until today the Karger program is 98% English!





Steven Karger (13.1.1959 – 5.3.2008)




- 1990: Managing Director of
 S. Karger GmbH, Freiburg (Germany)
- 1999: Joins S. Karger Publishers, Basel, as CEO
- 2008: Dies after a 2-year illness






