# OA Support

Researchers, teachers and students at Semmelweis University can apply for central support  
**in Scimago Journal Ranking top 10% (D1) journals.**

Amount of support:  
**50% of the invoiced list price (APC).**

# Terms and conditions

## Personal requirements:

The affiliation of the corresponding author and one of the first and last authors includes Semmelweis University.

## Journal requirements:

The journal is highly prestigious in its field, with a D1\* rating (TOP 10% according to SJR).

\*The ranking is based on the Central Library's analysis of publications uploaded to the MTMT and included in the WoS database.

The journal is included in the list of "Supported Journals."

## Requirements for publication:

Type of supported publication:

Original Article, Research Article,

Review Article

Publications published in special sections and are classified as **„Article“** or **„Review“** in

Web of Science

(Based on individual evaluation)

# How does the support work?

1. Uploading  
The author uploads the manuscript to publisher's editorial system.
2. Review process by the publisher  
After „peer review“, the publisher informs the author about its decision.
3. Request for support  
After the publication has been accepted, the author must indicate their request for support to the Central Library.
4. OA support (details on slide 6)  
The author's organisation pays the full invoice, after that the Central Library transfers 50% of the list price.

# Notification of intention to publish

After the publication has been accepted, the corresponding author should indicate His/her request for OA support by email to [ejournals@semmelweis.hu](mailto:ejournals@semmelweis.hu).

The email has to include the following informations:

- Name of publisher and journal.
- A version of the manuscript with affiliations is attached.
- A statement that the affiliations listed in the manuscript remain unchanged on the published version.

# Payment of OA support In case of transfer

## The invoice payment process

The correspondent's department arranges for payment of the invoice, i.e., orders and pays the full amount shown on the invoice.

After payment, it is necessary to send the following to the Central Library

- a **copy of the invoice** with the total amount of the APC in foreign currency, and
- the **bank statement** of the payment
- the name and contact details of the administrator

The Central Library transfers the 50% subsidy amount to the department. To do this, please **specify the target fund and the institution's letter code**.

# Payment of OA support For students

## The invoice payment process

**If the author of the correspondence is a student at Semmelweis University** and has no legal relationship with any organizational unit or department, the Central Library will notify the publisher that it requests a shared invoice and will settle the 50% subsidy amount.

In this case, the conditions for receiving support are as follows:

- the proportion of authors affiliated with Semmelweis University exceeds **50%** in the article, **or**
- Semmelweis University should be included in the affiliation of the corresponding author, the first author, and the last author.

The Central Library informs the publisher that it requests a split invoice and settles the 50% subsidy amount. The author declares the invoicing information for the fee reduced by the 50% subsidy amount and arranges for its payment.
